

SCHOLARSHIPS

Terms & Conditions

Scholarships are not loans; therefore, it is unnecessary for them to be repaid. However, with most scholarship programs, recipients must meet certain conditions, adhere to a standard of conduct throughout the term of the scholarship, and must be available to assist in furthering the mission of the organization that bestowed the award.

The Conservatory must ensure scholarships are primarily awarded to students who are serious, disciplined and dedicated to their training. In order to maintain consistency in the student's training, scholarship recipients must agree not to take ballet classes or other dance classes at any other studio or with private instructors without the express approval of the Conservatory.

If at any time during the awarded scholarship term the recipient fails to maintain 'good standing' at the Conservatory, the scholarship may be revoked and set aside for another scholarship applicant's use.

For reporting purposes to the IRS and Guam Department of Revenue & Taxation, the Conservatory may require scholarship applicants to submit financial documents that attest to the applicant's financial need. All such requested disclosures will be held securely and confidentially by the Conservatory and used only for official purposes.

By applying for a scholarship, the student and his/her parent should be prepared to fulfill the entirety of the scholarship program's term as follows:

- 1. Requisite class attendance throughout the scheduled term.** Absences from class are excused only in instances of sickness. As long as the studio is open for business, students are expected to attend class. Unexcused absences are grounds for scholarship revocation.
- 2. Demonstrative progress of materials presented.** If the scholarship recipient fails to meet expectations with regard to his/her training progress, the recipient may be notified of risk of forfeiture of the scholarship.
- 3. Ongoing behavioral 'good standing.'** "Good standing" denotes that the student uphold an agreed upon code of conduct which may include, but not be limited to, showing up on time, respecting staff and other students, not engaging in illicit drug usage or in any criminal wrongdoing, and conducting him/herself in a manner befitting an ambassador of the Conservatory's arts education program.
- 4. Participation in the Mission.** In order for the Conservatory to fulfill its charitable and educational mission, the attendance and participation of scholarship recipients at the Conservatory's events, workshops, seminars and performances is expected when the Conservatory requests it. All efforts shall be taken to ensure the health and well being of scholarship recipients and that respect is extended to them with regard to their time and energy so as to not unduly burden them with unreasonable requirements.
- 5. Training Exclusivity.** Scholarship recipients shall not take ballet classes or receive private instruction outside of the Conservatory without express approval from the Conservatory.
